SEQUENCE OF MILITARY HONORS AT A STATE VETERANS CEMETERY

- Quick **opening prayer**, 5 minutes max. (optional)
- Firing Party, optional for veterans but required for retirees and active duty
- Taps, (required)
- Flag Fold, (required) no reading of the meaning of each fold (unless family wants this), takes time away from families who are there to honor their loved one(s).
 - Military honors takes roughly 8-10 min. -
- Family's discretion (i.e. Chaplain, Minister, Priest, or family/friends can say something)
- In vehicles and **departing cemetery.** Families are allotted <u>30 minutes</u> (including the time allotted for military honors) for their service to ensure that cemetery staff have enough time to perform their interment duties prior to the start of the next service. 30 minutes is the standard in all veterans' cemeteries in the U.S.

Reminder our facilities are for military honors not funerals services.

Any deviations must be coordinated and approved in advance with the Cemetery Manager!



Have you ever been in a cemetery and saw coins laying on a headstone? A coin left on a headstone lets the deceased veteran's family know that somebody stopped by to pay their respect.



A penny means you visited.



A nickel means you and the deceased veteran trained at boot camp together.



A dime means you and the deceased veteran served together in some capacity.





A quarter is very significant because it means that you were there when that veteran died.

The tradition of leaving coins on the headstones of military men and women can be traced to as far back as the Roman Empire. Soldiers would insert a coin into the mouth of a fallen soldier to ensure they could cross the "River Styx" into the afterlife. In the US, this practice became common during the Vietnam war, due to the political divide in the country over the war, leaving a coin was seen as a more practical way to communicate that you had visited the grave than contacting the soldier's family, which could devolve into an uncomfortable argument over politics relating to the war.

What happens to the coins? It is collected from the gravesites monthly and the money is used for cemetery maintenance, the cost of burial for soldiers, or the care for indigent soldiers.



MONTANA STATE VETERANS CEMETERIES FLORAL REGULATIONS



- 1. Fresh cut flowers may be placed on graves at any time and will be removed as soon as they start to wilt.
- 2. Floral items and other types of decorations may not be secured to headstones or niches. Balloons are not allowed at any time.
- 3. Artificial flowers may be placed on graves only during the period of November 16 March 15.
- 4. Planting is not permitted on graves at any time.
- 5. Potted plants are permitted 7 days before and 7 days after Easter and Memorial Day.
- 6. During the lawn mowing and ground maintenance season, all floral items will be removed from graves prior to mowing.
- 7. U.S. Flags are only authorized on graves during Memorial Day, otherwise they will be removed when found.
- 8. Christmas wreaths are permitted on graves during the Christmas season and will be removed no later than January 20thf each year.
- 9. Statues, shepherd's hooks, vigil lights, breakable objects of any nature, or pinwheels are not permitted on graves at any time.
- 10. The cemetery staff is not responsible for any items placed on graves or retaining them.
